Scope of Job

Main Duties

1. Under the guidance and support of the Catalyst Project Worker and your designated Team Leader drive the Catalyst youth bus to agreed locations across Greater Manchester working alongside a team of experienced youth workers and Greater Manchester Police.
2. Ensure the safety of the youth vehicle by performing mandatory vehicle checks before taking the youth bus out of the youth centre car park
3. always Drive the vehicle in a safe and legal manner and ensure the safety of any passengers who accompany you in the cab.
4. Be involved in each session, providing support to the team leader and engaging with the young people.
